Paper submission and publication

Papers will be published in electronic form as a publication of the MEDICON 2010 Proceedings which will be available to registrants of the conference when the conference opens. The proceedings will be published within the peer reviewed Springer Verlag IFBME Proceedings Series. Each contribution must be prepared according to the IFBME Proceedings Series format. Manuscripts should be up to four (4) pages long and should be submitted electronically before the paper submission deadline (18 Jan 2010) using the paper submission link of the conference web site (www.medicon2010.org). All submissions will be peer-reviewed by at least two reviewers. All accepted papers will be included in the conference proceedings, provided that at least one registration is attached to it before March 20, 2010 in order to be included in the conference proceedings. Authors must accept the copyright conditions which will be given on the Conference Website.
